



ASV vēstniecība aicina studentus pieteikties Study of the U.S. Institutes (SUSI) stipendiju programmai. SUSI programma ir piecu nedēļu apmācības programma ASV 2019. gada vasarā. Programmas gaitā studenti varēs iegūt dziļāku izpratni par ASV, uzlabot līderības prasmes, iepazīties un dalīties pieredzē ar ASV mācībspēkiem un citu valstu studentiem, kā arī piedalīties izglītojošos semināros, diskusijās un lekcijās. Programmas ietvaros tiek piedāvāti divi kursi:

ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Uzņēmējdarbība un ekonomiskā attīstība

The program will provide participants with an overview of entrepreneurial approaches by reviewing the development, history, challenges, and successes of U.S. entrepreneurial enterprises, including social enterprises, business leadership and women's economic empowerment, in the United States and globally. Topics may include, but are not limited to, trade, investment, financial literacy, banking, microfinance, organizational development and management, innovation, emerging markets and risk analysis, strategic business planning, corporate social responsibility, and minorities in entrepreneurship. The academic sessions will be complemented with hands-on sessions or workshops designed to build skills in the topics mentioned above.

YOUTH, EDUCATION AND CLOSING THE SKILLS GAP

Jaunatne, izglītība un trūkstošo prasmju nodrošināšana

The program will explore how advances in technologies such as artificial intelligence, automation, and robotics are shaping how we work, where we work, and the skills and education required to work. The Institute will expose participants to global issues in the context of the future of work by examining educational, social and economic trends. Using an interdisciplinary approach, the academic program will examine the role of U.S. educational institutions, particularly community colleges, in preparing Americans with the skills needed to succeed in multiple industries and sectors including business, technology, science, higher education, the creative arts and other fields. Topics may include, but are not limited to, communication, entrepreneurship and the gig economy, globalization and urbanization, innovation and technology, organizational development and management, skills development, and reskilling and retraining. The Institute will also provide opportunities for participants to engage with educational and industry leaders, policy makers, trade associations and other key actors.
