












## Welcome to EM Strasbourg Business School!

# PRACTICAL INFORMATION

#### Level

Undergraduate (Students must have completed at least 1 year of higher education)

#### Language requirements

Proficiency in English (minimuml level of B2 in English according to the Common European Reference Framework of Languages).

#### **Prerequistes**

Open to undergraduate students with a basic knowledge of business and/or economics.

Nominations for individuals from other disciplines will also be considered.



#### **Accomodation**

Students are accommodated in student residence halls near the School. Students are responsible for housing costs and should budget around 350 – 500 euros for accommodation. Further information will be sent to applicants. Students are expected to arrive 1-2 days prior to the beginning of the programme (reservations will be made accordingly).



## CLASSES

## & LECTURES

All classes, lectures and visits will be held in English. Kindly note that students are required to take all the classes from the first two modules.

This year, our international business program will also have a focus on sustainability.

The courses in the program amount to the equivalent of 12 ECTS credits (6 US credit hours).

Students are required to take all classes on the syllabus.
