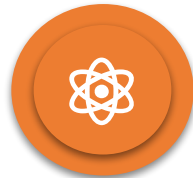

# Mobile Protection Hub- in progress

The PRO-FIL Foundation is implementing the 'Mobile Protection Hub' project between 01.02.2024 and 31.12.2024. The project is funded by UNHCR, the UN Refugee Agency, under the grant programme of the Empowering Children Foundation.

The project aims to support the integration of refugees in Poland by providing information, career counselling and psychological support. Activities are implemented in the Podkarpackie Voivodeship.

In 2022 and 2023. we implemented:

**260 group workshops** and more than **2,500 individual psychological consultations**

In 2024. we have already implemented:

**20** integration workshops (**143 people**),

**125** people benefited from individual psychological support,

**403** people benefited from the mobile information point

Piloting: **individual professional coaching - 89 people; group workshops - 57 (594 people)**







# Ukraine Response

---

The project was implemented in cooperation with the **Amna** foundation. As part of the project, we implement integration workshops for children and young people in primary and secondary schools. Classes, some of which are Ukrainian youth, are included in the activities. The project will run until the end of the current school year.

## „sPROFILowana pomoc psychologiczna!” - 2 editions

Project financed by **PFRON** - psychological support for citizens of Ukraine. Implemented in total in 2023 and 2024:

- **1500 h** of individual psychological counselling for 80 persons with disabilities
- **250 h** of group psychological workshops for carers of persons with disabilities

## „Wsparcie- Rozwój – Integracja” – II 2024 r. – VI 2024 r.;

The project was financed by the PCPM under the POP Fund.

Supporting schoolchildren (from Ukraine and Poland) in the field of mental health, integration and knowledge of the labour market and the pedagogical staff working with them from the area of the municipality of Zarzecze.

As part of the project, the following activities were implemented:

- **16** integration workshops (**321 people**)
- **16** activation workshops (**321 people**)
- **80h** individual psychological support - **19 people**
- **10** teachers were covered by workshops on working methods, integration, communication, building relationships

**In total 179 refugees from Ukraine were supported**

# We are opening The Children's Aid Centre!

**The Children's Aid Centre** is a facility based on the Barnahus model, where children who have been victimised by crime and their caregivers receive comprehensive and interdisciplinary help at one place. This means that the case of a child who comes into the care of the Centre is handled from start to finish by a group of the same professionals.



# The Children's Aid Centre

## For whom is The Children's Aid Centre?

- For children who have experienced physical abuse, psychological abuse, neglect, sexual abuse.
- For children in suicidal crisis - related to the experience of crime/violence.
- For non-offending parents and/or carers - each child needs a supportive adult!

**All services provided at CPD are free of charge.**

Now there are 10 Children's Aid Centres in Poland and it's time for Rzeszow!
